

Sweet and Sour Salmon

4- 6oz salmon fillets
1 teaspoon Adobo seasoning Cooking spray
1/3 cup honey
1/4 cup Cider vinegar
1/4 cup pineapple juice

1. Sprinkle skinless sides of fish with adobo seasoning. Heat a grill pan over medium heat. Coat pan with cooking spray. Add fish, seasoned side down, to pan; cook 4 minutes. Spray fish with cooking spray; turn fish over, cook 4 minutes or until fish flakes easily when tested with a fork or until desired degree of doneness.

2. While fish cooks, combine honey, vinegar and pineapple juice in a small sauce pan over medium high heat; bring to a boil. Reduce heat, and simmer 10 minutes or until sauce is syrupy and reduced to about 1/3 cup. Spoon sauce over fish before serving.

Serves 4 (1 fillet and about 4 teaspoons sauce.)
