President's Message

Hello Team, thanks for giving me and all the members the opportunity to serve on the Board of Directors. We are all honored to make decisions that are in the best interest of our members and the Ranch.

We have had some successes and encountered some challenges. The largest immediate challenge is the indoor pool. It continues to sink into the ground. We are evaluating options at present.

On the positive front, someone who has chosen to remain unidentified, has decided to donate a UTV to the Ranch. Please understand, this is not a used vehicle. It arrived Wednesday (July 30) brand new from the dealer. I am speechless in trying to say thank you.

The work on the website is progressing nicely. We hope to have it complete and in service in the next 30 days.

Headcount continues to rise. Visitors, short term rentals, leaseholders and residents have all seen increases. Many thanks to the Council in ensuring we do not loose who we are as we grow. The conversation concerning a rejected application is not easy but is sometimes necessary.

A special shout out to you all as members. Without you all selling the Ranch to guests and friends, we would not have the activity we do.

At our July Board meeting, I announced our plan to vote on a rate increase at our August Board meeting. That may slip to September. Honestly, we are discussing the options and may not be ready to vote in August. Regardless of when we vote, implementation will be at least two months post vote. As I said in July, I am suggesting a 20% increase in short term rentals and day passes. Additionally, an increase in memberships and lease payments of 10%. Let me be clear, my fellow Board members have their own ideas so this is by no means settled.

The need for the increase lies in the cost of running the Ranch. Electricity, water, and propane have all increased immensely.

Thanks for all you do, the Ranch would not be the same without each and everyone of you.


