


Margie Hall: A "Star" Whose Brightness Has Increased Tenfold Since Her Passing.

Historians believe the first maypole dance originated as part of Germanic pagan fertility rituals. Originally, the dancers danced around a living tree. The dance is performed on May 1 to welcome spring.


