For example, (true story) we had a member invite friends they had known for a little over two years, they followed procedures and had them go to the office. We found in the background check that the male had been convicted of robbery and assault with a deadly weapon 4 years before and spent 18 months in jail and was on parole. The member was not aware of the person’s background, he did know that he had a temper and sometimes could not control it.

We have had similar examples where the friend had been convicted of and served time for molestation of a child. Once again, the member was not aware of the past.

Having been a police officer for a little over 6 years I have seen and dealt with the dangers these kind of people are capable of, that’s why I take this so seriously. With today’s environment where known neighbors kill people for no reason, I don’t want anything to take place that would haunt us all for the rest of our lives.

My commitment to all our members and visitors is to provide a safe environment where people can leave the outside world behind and enjoy “paradise” at Star Ranch.


Check emails and bulletin boards for the next meeting for the 2017 AANR-SW Convention planning.
