

Sahnoan Council Meeting Minutes 7.10.2022

Meeting called to order at 10:00AM

Reviewed Minutes of 6.11. Minutes accepted without comment.

Reviewed and discussed recent activities to include:

- Karaoke currently slated for once a month. A few members have requested more Karaoke. Frequency was discussed and decided we would expand to an hour here or there during DJ events.
- Mulky was discussed, decided to reschedule as the weather cools off.
