Update from the Office

Office is Getting a New Booking System: Camplife

The office staff are anticipating going “live” with Camplife at the end of February. The exact date is yet to be determined as we work with the Camplife developer to ensure we have our site customized to our needs with the appropriate rates applied to each reservation type. This booking platform is the one used by many campgrounds across the U.S. and Canada. You can see the Camplife landing page at <https://www.camplife.com/>. You will *NOT* see our presence on their landing page until we go live.

When we book a reservation, the confirmation from this new system will electronically provide the documents via email that we currently have signed in the office upon check-in. The visitor will sign the documents electronically, and the documents automatically are saved to their reservation. The documents provided for signature are based on how we book the reservation. If we include children or pets on the reservation, the system automatically sends the appropriate documents to be signed for either pets, children or both, as applicable to the individual reservation.

This is but one of many enhanced features that Camplife provides over our current booking system. We are implementing in stages, with basic reservations being the first step. Stay tuned for more updates and information about the system as we progress toward full implementation.

New Confirmation Numbers for Reservations

In preparation for going live with Camplife, all reservations currently booked through our old reservation system will be entered into Camplife on February 23 & 24, 2026. If you have a reservation (or more than one reservation) you will receive a confirmation email from Camplife for each reservation. Please check each reservation confirmation carefully. We are entering these manually. We strive to have no errors and you can help identify if we achieved that goal by double checking your confirmation emails very carefully.

- WINTER FIRE SAFETY -

Winter brings a heightened risk of residential fires, with [half of all home heating fires](#) occurring during December, January, and February. The leading cause of these incidents is **heating equipment**, particularly space heaters, which are involved in approximately 40% of such fires. To mitigate risks, maintain a [three-foot "kid-free" and "pet-free" zone](#) around fireplaces and heaters.

Key hazards include:

- **Electrical Overloads:** Plugging multiple heat-producing appliances into a single outlet or using thin extension cords for high-wattage heaters can lead to overheating.
 - **Holiday Hazards:** Dried-out Christmas trees and unattended candles significantly increase fire risk.
 - **Ventilation Issues:** Blocked chimneys or improper use of generators indoors can lead to fatal carbon monoxide buildup.
- Improper Ash Disposal:** Hot ashes should only be stored in metal containers kept far from the home.

Regular inspections of furnaces and testing of smoke alarms remain the most effective defenses against winter tragedies.


