Springtime Indoor Fire Safety & Maintenance

- **Smoke and Carbon Monoxide Alarms:** Test all alarms monthly and replace batteries during daylight saving time (the "Change Your Clock, Change Your Battery" rule). Entire smoke alarm units should be replaced every **10 years**.
- **Dryer Vents:** Clean the lint filter after every load and perform a deep clean of the exhaust duct and outdoor vent flap at least once a year to prevent lint buildup, a leading cause of home fires.
- **Kitchen Safety:** Degrease the exhaust hood and air filters to prevent stovetop fires from spreading. Always stay in the kitchen while cooking on the stovetop.
- **Electrical Hazards:** Inspect appliance cords for fraying or damage and replace them immediately if found. Avoid overloading outlets or using extension cords as permanent wiring.

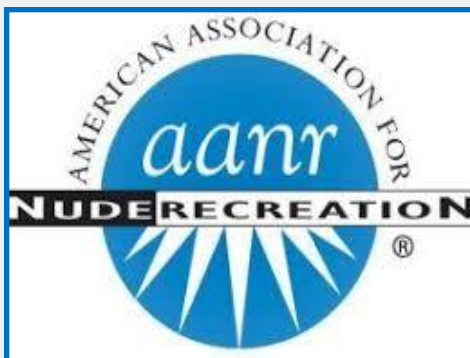
